IAN DUNCAN ENTERS KENYA AIRWAYS RALLY

Former Safari Rally winner and multiple Kenya National Rally champion, Ian Duncan has entered the Kenya Airways East African Safari Classic Rally 2009 again after the last attempt in 2007.

Driving a powerful 5 litre engine Ford Mustang he will be navigated by his regular co-driver Amaar Slatch. The 1967 model Ford Mustang is currently being prepared at his Karen workshops.

During the 2007 event Ian Duncan showed the speed of his Mustang and was lying in 3rd position overall when the “input shaft” on his gearbox broke due to the strain of the powerful 5 litre engine.

Ian Duncan who won the Safari Rally in 1994 when it was a round of the World Rally Championship will join 45 other crews who have entered so far on this the “World Greatest Classic Car Rally”. The event will cover a marathon 4100 kilometres taking the crews through the remote and beautiful landscapes of Kenya and Tanzania from 22nd November to 1st December 2009.

“I am really looking forward to driving the Ford Mustang which will be much better prepared since we have learnt a lot about the car in the 2007 event and also the KNRC before we started to drive the Nissan Patrol. It should give me all the things I love in rallying in one event” said the four times Kenya rally champion.

The 2009 Kenya Airways East African Safari Classic rally has been scheduled outside the international rally calendar to give an opportunity for international and local media coverage to be at its maximum. Access Kenya will be providing Internet connectivity all around the rally route to beam out the latest stories and rally news to the world’s media houses.
