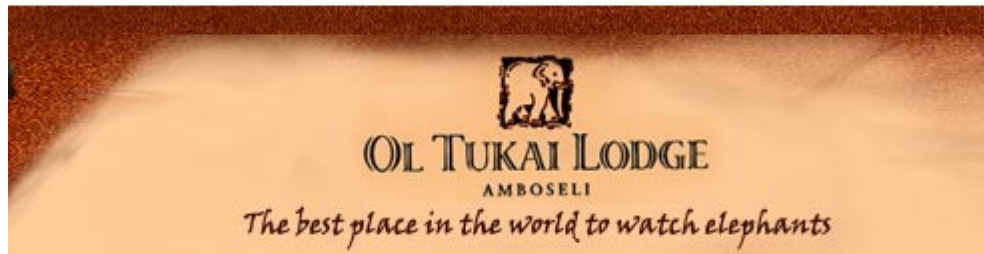

The buildings are spaciouly laid out and the property has well maintained flat lawns , gardens and wide open spaces. It is an ideal spot for star gazers in the African tropical nights. The property overlooks Africa's highest peak, Mount Kilimanjaro and the Amboseli plain to the south and the eastern boundary is home to several families of elephant known to be amongst the best spots in the world to watch elephant. The rally service area and parc ferme will be at Ol Tukai lodge and the service area is patrolled by armed Kenya Wildlife rangers to keep away the elephants and baboons.

Amboseli National Park

Amboseli National Park provides the classic Hollywood image of Africa. Set in rolling savannah scenery it is dwarfed by the presence of the pink-tinged, snow-capped peak of Mount Kilimanjaro which, at 5,896 meters, is the highest free-standing mountain in the world and topped by one fifth of all the ice in Africa. Against this magnificent backdrop roam vast herds of elephant accompanied by a kaleidoscope of other fabulous beasts - lion, buffalo, cheetah, giraffe, baboon, gazelle hippo and wildebeest to name but a few. There are also over 400 species of birds, all manner of reptilian, flora and fauna and some of the most soul-searing views in Africa.

LAKE NAIVASHA SOPA LODGE - RALLY NIGHTSTOP HOTEL **Friday 25th November & Saturday 26th November 2011**



Situated on the southern shores of Lake Naivasha, second largest of only two freshwater lakes in Kenya's Great Rift Valley, Naivasha Sopa Lodge is an impressive property with a dramatic backdrop.

The lake is the stage of some magnificent storms and was named Nai Pasha (Rough Water) by the Maasai tribes.

An ornithologist's paradise, the lake is home to 400 species of wonderful birdlife and an abundance of fish and water life.

The surrounding landscape is host to a variety of game including giraffe, buffalo, and the elusive black faced colobus monkey and, in the lake itself to many hippos that can be seen grazing within the lodge grounds. Activities that can be arranged at Naivasha Sopa Lodge include horse-riding, bird-watching, fishing, water sports, cycling, lake trips and nature trails.

Sopa Means welcome in the Maasai language. We have adopted this traditional greeting for our organization because a warm welcome is the embodiment of each and every one of our destinations in Naivasha, Amboseli and Maasi Mara.

The Sopa concept is also one of environmental care and conservation. Of constant concern to us is the impact of our lodges on the flora and fauna in their surroundings. Africa's natural heritage is fragile and precious and we strive to set an example of wise ecological management with all our lodges by learning to work with nature and not against it.

NAIVASHA SIMBA LODGE – ACCOMODATION ONLY HOTEL **Friday 25th & Saturday 26th November 2011**



Location

Located 90 minutes away from Nairobi by road, Naivasha has long been the place for those seeking to get away from it all. Joy Adamson, author of Born Free made the shores her home, so did Lord Errol and a host of other well-known personalities. At 1880m above sea level, the air is cool, crisp and reinvigorating.

The Naivasha Simba Lodge is situated on the banks of Lake Naivasha, the cleanest lake in the Great Rift Valley. This fresh water lake was once Nairobi's main landing strip for the luxury Flying Boats that came all the way from London. Travelers would then proceed to Nairobi by bus. It has no known outlet, which is considered a requisite for a fresh water lake and it is thought that the outlet is underground!



Ambiance

You will feel your nerves quiet down as soon as you set your eyes on the lodge's rich, manicured grounds. From here, the Mount Longonot, an extinct volcano, towers behind the lake imparting a soft, purple tinge. These idyllic grounds upon which the Naivasha Simba is set, together with its countryside look make it the perfect location for conferences, wedding receptions, honeymoons and private retreats. The world-class lodge has had the pleasure of hosting a number of important international conferences, with the Sudanese Peace Agreement

that was attended by 15 heads of states and dignitaries such as Thabo Mbeki, Kofi Annan, Collin Powell and US senators, among them.

**VOI WILDLIFE LODGE – RALLY NIGHTSTOP HOTEL – Sunday
27th November 2011**



Nestled in the heart of elephant country, Voi Wildlife Lodge is located in the Savannah grasslands of Tsavo East, just 5km from the great highway linking Nairobi to Mombasa near the town of Voi.

Officially opened in 2003, the lodge is located on a 25 acre plot on the boundary of the Tsavo East National Park, with spectacular views of the volcanic outcrops of Kasigau and Sagala Hills. Designed to blend into the surrounding landscape the lodge is near a big water hole which attracts all kinds game like Buffalo, Cheetah, Lions and of course thousands of elephant. Temperatures average around 30 degrees and gets cooler at night in the month of November.
